- Oversees transportation activities and related expenses at a macro level; then address exceptions/variations/trends at the micro level
- Acts as subject matter expert on contracts from the business perspective including vetting contract exceptions
- Accountable for Logistics Service Center and SLG service offerings, customer service and the supporting processes (design and execution)
- Models transportation solutions with focus on mode shifting and the optimization of supply chain nodes
- Designs metrics for service and cost controls and monitors for compliance
- Constructs Standard Operating Procedures that promote industry best practices
- Manages projects for major operational initiatives (i.e., product recalls, technology enhancements)
- Analyzes rate structures and supporting tariff rules for truckload, less than truckload, and ocean shipping
- Supports sales with supporting research and industry trends (indices)
- Champions the value added services from both a payables and receivables perspective
- Manages direct reports which consist of Managers of Logistics Service Center and Performance Management Teams
- Accountable for 3rd party relationships (carriers, EcoBev facilities)
- Optimizes resources including assets, facilities, and personnel
- Drives continuous improvement by encouraging positive change in terms of operations structure, cost reduction, service enhancement, and quality control
- Champions educational initiatives that promote professional growth of all SLG employees
