- Assist in the extracting, compiling, and validating of data from multiple Supply Chain Management data systems including processing, cleansing, and verifying the integrity of data used for analysis.
- Interpret and analyze complex data sets, providing trends or patterns for operations, sales/marketing, finance, and clients through automated or ad hoc reports.
- Perform account audits and customer profiles to determine trends which will lead to recommendations on how to change behavior and improve results.
- Develop and implement report automation using various methods, such as Microsoft Power BI, Excel and Qlik Sense, to optimize efficiency and quality of business performance.
- Serve as a Subject Matter Expert assisting senior management with various tasks and items as needed.
- Co-ordinate with different functional heads/personnel as needed and to take on other tasks as assigned from time to time.
- Educate and train internal customers to use report automation tools for the purpose of analysis and option exploration.
